### **How to Read the Pattern**

We designed this pattern using simple knit (k) and purl (p) stitches so that it is appropriate for beginners. Each row lists the number of stitches that are needed and what type of stitch to use.

Examples:

- Row 1: k51 – Knitting projects are knit in rows. These symbols tell you to complete 51 stitches using the knit stitch.
- Row 7: k5, p28, k5, p8, k5 – These symbols tell you to complete 5 knit stitches, then 28 purl stitches, then 5 knit stitches, then 8 purl stitches, and finally 5 knit stitches.

## Gayzilla Wash Cloth Pattern

Cast On: 51 stitches

Row 1: k51

Row 11: k5, p5, k11, p1, k8, p1, k5, p10, k5

Row 12: k14, p7, k1, p20, k9

Row 14: k13, p9, k1, p3, k1, p9, k2, p6, k7

Row 15: k5, p2, k5, p5, k10, p1, k10, p8, k5

Row 16: k14, p10, k1, p8, k6, p5, k7
